Utility Worker; Water & Sewer

Position Summary and Scope of Responsibility

Manual work involving semi-skilled tasks in the installation, repair, and maintenance of municipal water distribution and sewer collection systems.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Locate water and sewer lines; replace and repair water/sewer lines, valves, and manhole covers
- Repair leaks, rebuild fire hydrants; serve as helper or assistant to skilled personnel
- Flag and direct traffic and establish traffic control measure to include installation of appropriate signaling devices
- Drive trucks; operate mechanized equipment; used hand tools, jackhammer, pipe wrenches; sandblast and paint as required to complete work assignments

Physical Requirements

Sufficient physical strength to lift at least 100 pounds. Perform other strenuous physical tasks over extended periods of time under varying weather conditions including the ability to climb/descend, balance and work at varying heights; ability to bend, stoop, crouch, and crawl. Must possess sufficient arm and hand strength to operate all required tools and equipment controls.

Necessary Requirements

Must possess a high school diploma or GED.

Must have an insurable driving record.

Must be able to obtain a Class A CDL with tanker endorsement.
